Note: Do you know when you will be required to use two factor authentication to login to eRA modules? The approach and deadline to transition to two-factor authentication is changing. To ensure the security of your eRA account, we are phasing in the requirement to use two-factor authentication (using Login.gov or a qualified InCommon Federated account). All scientific account holders should take action now to ensure continued access to their accounts, while administrative account holders will be required to move to two-factor authentication in early 2022.
