Multi-lingual REDCap

REDCap has options for multi-lingual teams. This area of REDCap is regularly having function/translation added to it, so contact your administrator if you have REDCap language needs.

Consider:

- 1. REDCap user interface can change the project settings to present in different languages. This will change the language presentation of some (not all) REDCap items for users logged into REDCap.
- 2. REDCap Survey respondent language presentation is controlled by the REDCap project developer.
 - a. There are some External Modules that will help present the REDCap Survey UI or Variable in the desired language. See the list below for helpful information:
 - i. The **Multilingual External Module** allows surveys and data entry forms to be translated into multiple languages. You must set up the module and language choices first, then build your instruments.

 - ii. The External Module **Survey UI Tweaks** will be your friend for studies that need parts of REDCap translated for the participant. This EM provides the ability to apply changes to the functioning parts of REDCap's presentation.
 - 1. This module runs after a page is opened and before it is presented to the participant. It will change the presentation of REDCap, but not the data collection function.
 - 2. These changes can be survey specific or global.
 - 3. For example, you can change the word "submit" to a new word.
